## **Eucharistic week in Carfin**

A Eucharistic week is taking place at Carfin leading up to the Feast of The Body and Blood of Christ, beginning on Monday 13<sup>th</sup> to Sunday 19<sup>th</sup> of June (Corpus Christi) – see posters on notice boards at entrance of the Church.

The Life in the Eucharist team will there each day of that week. There will be a 10am Mass and 1:00pm Mass each day and a 'Holy Hour' on Tuesday, Wednesday, Thursday and Friday at 7.00pm.

There will be an all-night vigil of the Blessed Sacrament in the Glass Chapel beginning after the 5.00pm Vigil Mass on the Saturday and concluding with a Dawn Mass for the 'Feast of Corpus Christi' in the Glass Chapel at 7:00am.

There will also be a Eucharistic Procession from St Teresa's Church, Newarthill, beginning at 3.00pm on the afternoon on Corpus Christi Sunday. Bishop Toal will preside at Benediction in the Grotto around 3.30pm – 4.00pm. He will also bless the new statue of Blessed Carlo Acutis, donated by the Life in the Eucharist Team.

UPDATE – A team of eight volunteers from St Teresa's to help share the carrying of the Canopy that will be carried above the Monstrance containing the Blessed Sacrament, is sought. If you are able to help in this way, please let Fr Kevin know.

St Teresa's Church will be opened to allow First Communicants, Altar Servers, Priests and Deacons to get prepared for the Procession.

Also, those taking part in the Procession are asked to assemble at the entrance to the car park/front of St Teresa's Church by 2.45pm.

We pray for good weather and a safe procession. It would be great to see as many as possible from St Teresa's attend the procession
