Last Sunday – 10th July was Sea Sunday, a day when we were asked to support the work of Stella Maris the maritime agency of the Catholic Church.

In the last year, more crews have been abandoned by their employers than ever before. Many are still being denied the right to leave their ships for even a short break away from the relentless noise and pressure onboard. Many are reporting more stress and poorer mental health.

Sea Sunday is when the Church prays for all those who live and work at sea. Your support will make a big difference to seafarers and fishers in need.
