

## *The Twenty First Sunday of Ordinary Time*

This coming week will be a **week of Blessings** for the parish as we prepare for the visit of the **Relics of St Therese** our patron Saint. Apologies for the cancellation of Tuesday evening's Mass. We have once more printed the details of the services on Thursday and Friday morning. Everyone is most welcome to attend these services. **St Therese is patron saint of the Missions.** We are so aware of the wonderful work of the Holy Ghost Fathers who will be hosting an exhibition of their apostolate in the Little Flower Hall on Saturday and Sunday to which everyone is very welcome. **Thank you** from the Holy Ghost Fathers for the support given to their raffle. **Thank you** to parishioners who attended our parish day at Carfin with P7 from the school. Most enjoyable. **Thank you** to parishioners who have signed up to be involved in the all night vigil in the company of the relics of St Therese. **Please feel free to add your name to the list.**

A **number of parishioners** have placed petitions in the basket which will be present during the visit of the relics. **All parishioners are encouraged to do this should they wish.**

**Thank you for the flower collection.** Fresh flowers will be brought in to church. The consecration candles have been refurbished and put back in place. Special new candles have been purchased the '**Big Six**'. A new vestment has been ordered. Church windows have been cleaned and all church carpets. A **new plaque** will be placed beside the new statute of St Therese to **commemorate** this week's historic events.

On **Monday the 26th, Tuesday the 27th** and **Wednesday the 28th** of August a Triduum of prayer will take place including Devotions with Exposition, Masses in the morning at **09.30am** and in the evening at **7.00pm.** (Except for Tuesday).

On **Thursday August 29th** the **Relics of St Teresa** will be brought to our parish. Devotions with Exposition followed by Mass will take place in the morning at **09:05am.** The evening and night arrangements are as follow:

**7.00pm** Mass in honour of St Teresa.

When the Relics arrive (we do not know the exact time) there will be a **Ceremony of Welcome and a Blessing of Roses.** Parishioners are invited to bring a rose or roses for this event. Then .....

**Devotions** in honour of St Teresa with Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament concluding with Benediction. Then .....

**Keeping Vigil** throughout the Night with the Relics of St Teresa. The Vigil will include Rosary on the hour, prayers in honour of St Teresa, periods of silence.

On **Friday August 30th at 07.15am** Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament with Morning Prayers will take place. Then .....

**07:45am Devotions** in honour of St Teresa concluding with Benediction. Then .....

**08.45am Mass** in honour of St Teresa our patron Saint. Then .....

A **Service of Departure** with the opportunity to venerate the Relics.

**Finally,** the Relics of St Teresa will be carried to the **Shrine of Our Lady** at Carfin by the members of the Knights of St Columba. **Departure is scheduled for 10.15am.**

Take a look at the notice boards and see the variety of photographs that were taken of Therese Martin when she was a child and when she joined the convent. Each of these photographs adds to the appeal of this incredibly popular saint of the Catholic church.

On the evening of **Saturday August 31st at 4.30pm** and on the morning of **Sunday September 1st at 10.00pm** Mass will be celebrated in honour of St Teresa of Lisieux our patron Saint.
